According to the Dutch government we are in the "light green" situation, which means in addition to the generally applicable hygiene measures we focus on persons who are at higher health risk.

School-specific regulations and policies at DISDH are as follows:

scenario	measures
Standard scenario All schools stay fully open	General hygiene measures (wash hands, cough and sneeze into the bend of the arm, stay home if symptoms occur and perform self-test)
	In the classroom: regular ventilation, CO ₂ measuring devices are available
	In case of contact with positive case: affected classes/staff members will be informed, it is recommended to get tested. Self-tests will be provided by the school
	If tested positive: self-isolation, return to school after a minimum of 5 days if symptom-free for 24 hours, otherwise after a maximum of 10 days
Additional focus on individuals at risk for health issues (current scenario)	Arrangements will be made with students and staff who are particularly at risk. The school will provide masks and self-tests as needed
	For students at high risk will be alternative lessons provided
Contact restriction measures. The school remains open	External persons (including AG providers, guardians, ...) are not allowed to enter the school.
	Only educational activities may take place (means no AGs etc.)
	Masks are worn in all meeting areas in the building. It is recommended to wear a mask in the classroom. It may be removed at the seating area.
	During breaks masks may be removed for eating and drinking in the designated break areas.
	A safety distance of 1.5 meters is maintained wherever possible.
Schools are not fully open to all	Only half classes may be on site at the school each day. Individual students will be on site every day, others will only be at home for health reasons
	Classes are divided into groups A and B. Siblings are usually assigned to group A. With the beginning of the red scenario, the daily change in classes begins with group A on the first day, group B followed on the second day and so on.
	LES/NMP and SchoolXL for grades 1-7 will still take place, but children may be excused from these by their parent/guardian.
	Alternate instruction can be hybrid or with work assignments for home. The decision for this is made by the respective teacher.
	Graduating classes (11 and 12) may continue to attend school each day at full class size.
